ECHS:

- Offers small autonomous model;
- Serves student populations underrepresented in higher education;
- Begins in 9th grade;
- Affords 60 credits or an Associate's
 Degree
- Provides academic and social support
- Eliminates all costs to students

Dual Credit:

- Serves college-bound students;
- Begins in 11th and 12th grades;
- Affords 24 credits maximum;
- Provides limited academic services;

Location & Transportation


 SA3 is located behind Sharyland High School in building A.
