- Early College High School
- Students can earn a High School Diploma and up to 60 college credits
- Provides dual credit at no cost to students
- Offers rigorous instruction and accelerated courses

- Reduces barriers to college access

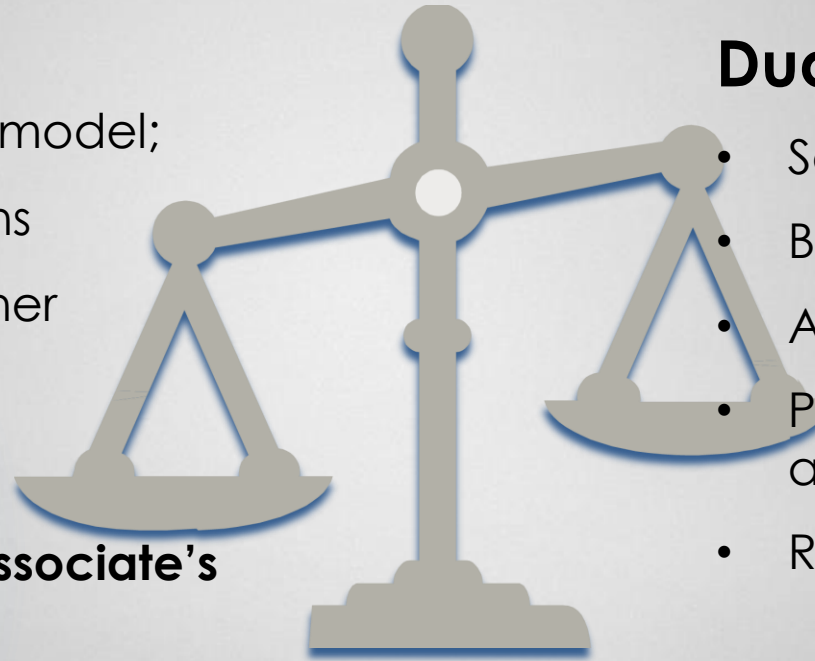

Early College High School vs. Dual Credit

ECHS:

- Offers small autonomous model;
- Serves student populations underrepresented in higher education;
- Begins in 9th grade;
- Affords **60 credits or an Associate's Degree**
- Provides academic and social support
- Eliminates all costs to students



Dual Credit:

- Serves college-bound students;
- Begins in 11th and 12th grades;
- Affords 24 credits maximum;
- Provides limited academic services; and
- Requires course fees.

Associate Degrees Offered

- ▶ Interdisciplinary Studies
- ▶ Engineering*
- ▶ Biology*
- ▶ Computer Science*

* Must meet certain eligibility requirements.

Interdisciplinary Studies Associate's Degree

- 9th Grade : 1 to 2 DC Classes
- 10th Grade : 2 to 3 DC Classes
- 11th Grade : 4 to 6 DC Classes
- 12th Grade : 6+ DC Classes
- Summer School DC Classes and Online DC Classes will be available.
- You may take some of your 11th / 12th Grade classes at STC.

Location & Transportation

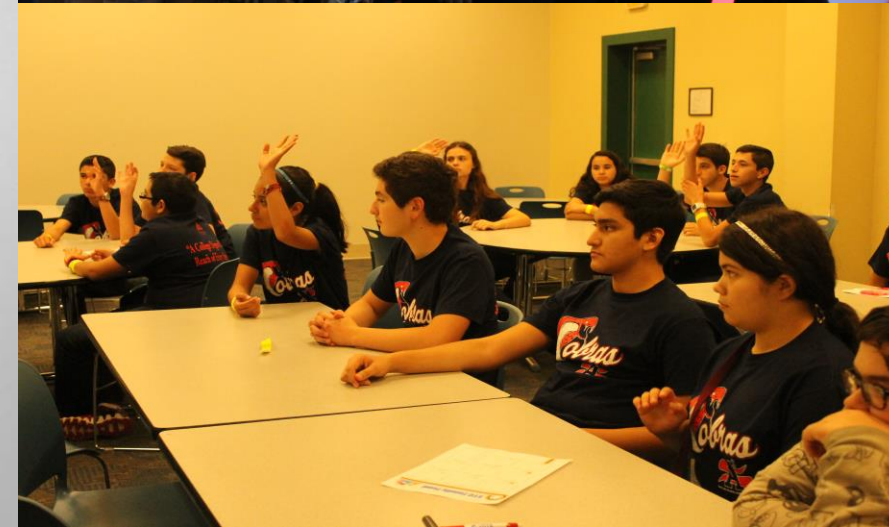
- SA3 is located behind Sharyland High School in building A.
